## Junior Warden's 2021 Annual Report

In January of 2021, we started implementing a vision of what could be at All Saints & Ascension. With a gentle nudge from our new Bishop, a committee was formed consisting of Rev. Renee, Senior Warden, Junior Warden, Nancy Hamilton and Michael Watson. The vision called for turning the Sanctuary around, removing the sacristy, the platform which the altar rested and removing the pews. We also wanted to save part of the pews (backs) to build new platform for new altar. We also expanded the size of the Sacristy, cleaned overhead lighting and went with energy efficient led bulbs. I want to thank Clarence Dula for his hard work & diligence in completing the first phase of project.

Phase two called for painting Sanctuary, outside doors and entryway, remove shades, put on new roof & gutters at entryway.

Phase three called for the laying of a new hardwood floor. This was necessary, not just for aesthetics, the tile floor beneath contained asbestos. You had to either cover it or do asbestos abatement, which could cost 10s of thousands of dollars. Our Senior Warden Bill Young took the lead and handled this phase. Thanks, Bill.

Phase four called for installing new cabinets, sink, pacinna, mirror and new lighting in sacristy. We also needed a new sound system, mikes, stands, equalizer, amps, lavaliers and speakers.

Phase five called for finding new seating. Thankfully, Nancy Hamilton took on this task. Thru covid shutdowns, supply chain issues, she doggedly, yet lovingly delivered our beautiful new chairs. Thank you, Nancy.

Phase six called for furnishing a new hand carved altar, credence tables, candle sticks, baptistry and presider's chair. Rev Renee took the lead with these words, "I think I know a guy." The results were magnificent. Thank you, Rev. Renee. Thank you, Bishop Deon Johnson, for your most generous gifts toward completing this phase.

Final phase of renovation was shepherded by Michael Watson with assistance of Nancy Hamilton, Rev. Renee & Bill Young. Portfolio Gallery was contacted to envision a new stain glass cross, with a Black Jesus. The results leave me in awe &

wonder. Thank you, Mike. We have something no other Church has. Thanks to the committee for your long journey and all your hard work.

During the year, it became quite clear that our sextant, Mr. Harold Briggs could no longer fulfill his duties as sextant because of his illness. We all owe Mr. Briggs a debt of gratitude for his more than twenty years of service to both All Saints and Ascension. I have been filling in as sextant in his absence since July. I created new listing for janitors' duties and responsibilities. We are actively looking for a janitor. We also replaced outside railing, added new lighting front and back. Fixed concrete issue in corner of building. Removed leaves from roof gutters. Had windows washed inside & outside. Passed Diocesan building inspection, only comment made was "you did this without an architect." Took inventory of storage facility. It has been my honor and pleasure to have served as your Junior Warden the past three years.

## PAYROLL ADMINISTRATOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The staff at All Saints and Ascension are paid twice each month, on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. Depending on when those dates fall on the calendar, they receive their direct deposits a day or two before.

The Payroll Administrator must submit each payroll at least two business days prior to the actual payday. Any staff member who works on an hourly basis must submit those hours to the administrator; so, that the report can be sent to our payroll vendor, Paychex, on time.

The Payroll Administrator must prepare a calendar for the upcoming year that displays both dates for each month:

1) Date payroll hours are submitted to Paychex and 2) Date of payday (Direct Deposit date)

Once the payroll has been submitted, the Payroll Administrator notifies the Treasurer by providing the figures needed for the church financial reports.

The Payroll Administrator is also responsible for any adjustments to payroll, which could include adding/deleting an employee, submitting changes to employee compensation, etc.
