

Cleopatra Harris Anderson was born December 16, 1922, to the union of William and Evelyn Harris in Birmingham, Alabama. She received an education at Miles College in Birmingham, Ala., in 1945 with a Bachelor of Science in Social Studies. She continued to support the school through the National Alumni Association over the years. She also received an Elementary Education Certificate from Harris Teachers College in St. Louis, MO and a Special Education Certificate from Washington University in St. Louis, MO. She was employed with the St. Louis Public Schools from 1957-1974. She worked as a classroom teacher for the mentally retarded - primary, intermediate and upper levels. She retired early to be a full-time caregiver to her mother.

She confessed her faith early in life that continued for over 100 years. She was united in Holy Matrimony to Joseph S. Anderson, Sr. - who passed away in 1979 and to this union five children were born. Mother Cleo lived a long eventful, life of 100 + years always keeping God first. She was a good mother to her children and many other children.

She was a charter member and President of the St. Louis Area Council for Exceptional Children. She served as a charter member and President of the St. Margaret's Guild at All Saints Episcopal Church and worked very closely with the Episcopal Women's auxiliary. She loved to dance and enjoyed life to the fullest and will be truly missed!

She departed this life in St. Louis, MO on July 11, 2023 and was preceded in death by her daughter, Nellie Evelyn Rosson. She leaves to cherish her memories Erma Shabazz, Frankie Jo Anderson, Thelma L. Harris (Arnold), and Joseph S. Anderson Jr. (Karen), 12 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, and adopted family.
